This Will was proved at London the Eleventh day of July in the year of Our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Eighty Three before the Worshipful **Andrew Coltee Ducorel** Doctor of Laws and surrogate of the Right Worshipful **Peter Calvert** Doctor of Laws Master Keeper or commissary of the prerogative court of Canterbury lawfully constituted by the oath of **SARAH ELIZABETH COLUMBINE** widow the Relict and sole executrix to whom administration was granted of all and singular the goods, chattels and credits of the deceased having been first sworn duly to administer.
